Integrating eBodhya with Your Academic Calendar

eBodhya works best when assessments are planned alongside your school's academic calendar. This guide helps you set up a term-aligned assessment schedule from the beginning of the year.

Board-Specific Considerations

CBSE — Use NCERT-aligned question bank. Blueprint matches official sample papers. Competency-based questions available for Classes 9–12.

ICSE — Chapter-wise questions follow CISCE prescribed syllabus. Long answer and structured questions available for core subjects.

IB — Assessment criteria aligned to IB Subject Guides. Higher-order questions emphasize analysis and evaluation.

Cambridge — Questions aligned to Cambridge syllabi (IGCSE and A-Level). MCQs and structured questions match paper formats.

State Boards — Subject and chapter structure follows state-specific textbooks. Board-specific blueprints available on request.

Assessment Planning Best Practices

- Plan chapter tests at the end of every chapter — not just before major exams
- Use diagnostic tests at the start of each term to identify prior knowledge gaps
- Space mock papers at least 3 weeks before board examinations
- Assign remediation worksheets within 5 days of evaluation results
- Schedule monthly analytics reviews with department heads
- Use class performance trends to calibrate teaching pace for the next chapter

Recommended Annual Assessment Structure

For a school following a two-term academic year with board examinations:

- Term 1 (June–October): 1 diagnostic + 4–6 chapter tests + 1 mid-term paper
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Term 2 (November–March): 4–6 chapter tests + 2 mock papers + board prep

- Total recommended assessments: 14–18 per subject per academic year
